Franklin Parks & Recreation Job Opportunities

Lifeguard

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department seeks a qualified individual for the position of Lifeguard. A Lifeguard monitors activities of swimmers enrolled in the Summer Camp at public bathing facilities to prevent accidents and provide assistance to swimmers; rescues swimmers in distress and performs life saving duties, including CPR, rescue breathing, and swimmer rescue techniques; performs directly related work as required.

This is a part-time, seasonal position. This position could be combined with a camp counselor position which would be a full-time, seasonal position. Lifeguard certification is preferred or willing to become certified and one to three years of related experience, or equivalent combination of experience. Lifeguard salary range \$9.00 to \$14.00 per hour. Position will remain open until filled.

Camp Counselor

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department seeks a qualified individual for the position of Camp Counselor. The Camp Counselor helps, implement, supervise, and run daily activities for children ages 5-13 during our summer camp; be a team player with the ability to juggle assignments and multi-task. This is a part-time (35-40 hours), seasonal position. Salary range \$7.25 to \$14.00 per hour. Applications will be accepted until position is filled.

Water Safety Instructor

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department seeks a qualified individual for the position of Water Safety Instructor. The Water Safety Instructor is responsible for planning, coordinating, and teaching the American Red Cross Learn-To-Swim course to participants ages 3-15. This is a part-time, seasonal position during the month of July. WSI certification is preferred or willing to become certified and one to three years of related experience, or equivalent combination of experience. Salary range \$10.00 to \$12.00 per hour. Position will remain open until filled.

Lake Host

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department seeks a qualified individual for the position of Lake Host. A Lake Host Inspector educates the public on aquatic invasive species and how to prevent their spread at Lagace Beach Boat Ramp on Webster Lake in Franklin, NH. This is a part-time (8-16 hours), seasonal position. Salary is \$10.00 per hour. Applications will be accepted until position is filled.
