Participates in experiential and outdoor adventure activities.

Maintain standards that lead to a quality program.

Works to make the program an enjoyable and safe place by enforcing conduct and safety rules.

Issues and collects equipment and supplies and teaches children proper methods of using and caring for equipment.

Conduct daily check of program area(s) and equipment for safety, cleanliness, and good repair.

File a report for repairs if necessary.

File a report and notify supervisor for any medical treatment provided to participants.

Supervise field trips and other mobile program activities.

Encourages participation by greatest number by providing activities of interest to those in various age groups.

Responsible for helping keep grounds and buildings clean, enlist the help of children.

Evaluates the program activities and makes recommendations for improvement.
